

# Unpaid Work Experience Participants' Eligibility

## What is an unpaid work experience?


- The Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministry of Immigration and Career Training and The Worker's Compensation Board lists the following criteria for a valid work experience:
  - participants are engaged with an employer;
  - without pay;
  - for more than one day;
  - in the performance of work normally undertaken by the employer;
  - for the purpose of learning;
  - the work experience must take place in Saskatchewan; and,
  - eligible employers are outlined in "Schedule A" of the MOU.

## Who is eligible?

- Participants who are engaged in an unpaid work experience with an approved training provider (refer to Schedule A of the MOU); **and** one of the following:
  - issued no payroll tax slip;
  - issued a T5 tax slip; or
  - issued a T4A tax slip.

## Who is not eligible?

- Participants in work experience programs with an approved training provider and issued a T4 tax slip.



It is the employers responsibility to contact CRA to determine which tax slip to issue.
