Background


Newly amended *Directive PNG034 - Saskatchewan Pipeline Codes (Section 5.2.1)* requires Industry users to obtain Ministry approval for pipeline segments that cross a watercourse, are within an area of sensitive surface/groundwater, or are within an urban municipality. A new 'Non-Routine Pipeline Abandonment' application has been created to help industry obtain these approvals.

Process


Take the following steps to submit the Non-Routine Pipeline Abandonment application:

Step 1: Log in to IRIS;

Step 2: Go to Applications → Petroleum and Natural Gas → Pipeline/Flowline Section → Non-Routine Pipeline Abandonment;



Step 3: Enter the Licence #, select applicable segments and fill in the contact information;



- Step 4: Attach an 'Abandonment Plan' and any other additional documents in the Attachments section;
- Step 5: Verify the information provided in the Preview Application section;
- Step 6: Agree to the eligibility statement and submit the application.

Note: All Non-Routine Pipeline Abandonment applications are subject to ER review. Additional information may be requested during the application review.
