



# Are You Going to Family Court?

Have you or your ex-partner applied to family court for child or spousal support, a parenting order, property division, or divorce?  
Do you need information about the court process?

## Request an Intake Assessment

At an intake assessment, a court screening officer can:

- provide general information about the steps in the court process.
- make referrals to useful resources and services, based on your situation.
- screen for family violence, and make referrals to support services.
- make sure you know about mandatory steps such as attending the Parenting After Separation program and dispute resolution.
