The Environmental Protection Branch of the Ministry of Environment regulates mining, industrial and waste management facilities within four regions. The facilities information is available through the [Saskatchewan Interactive](#) (SaskInteractive) mapping application.

## Facilities Dataset overview

### Available Information

The Saskatchewan Interactive mapping application allows individuals to search for the following information on Saskatchewan Facilities including:


1. Facility Name



Click on **Layers** tab on the bottom left corner of the web page.



Expand the **Environmental Protection** folder by clicking the plus sign.


- Put a check mark next to **Permitted Facilities** to turn on the facilities layer.
- Put a check mark next to **EPB Regions** to turn on the regional boundaries.



**Note:** Once this layer has been turned on, users can zoom in/out, pan and utilize the other interactive mapping functions as suited.


**View Details of a Facility on the Map**

**Notes:** To view facilities on the map, users must be in the **Permitted Facilities** layer before proceeding (as presented under **Access Facilities Information** section).




Click on the facility that needs to be reviewed.

A pop-up window will open to show the information of the facility.




Click **View Additional Details** on the pop-up information window.




The details of facility will be displayed on the left-hand side of the map.

## Getting Legal Land Descriptions or Geographic Point Information




Within the **Layers** box, there are multiple **Operational Layers** that can be turned on or off using the check boxes. Scroll down to the **Cadastral** layer and expand selection using the plus sign.




Using the check boxes, select one or multiple options to gain access to **Township, Section, Quarter Section, Plan, Block, Lot and Surface**. This information will automatically show up on your map when zoomed in.

## Finding Facilities Based on Name



**Note:** To access specific facilities based on name, users must be in the **Permitted Facilities** layer before proceeding (as presented above).




Using the **Search** box located on the top right of the screen, type in the name of facility. A list of Search Results will appear on the left side of the screen. Scroll through the search results. Clicking on results will allow access to additional detailed information.

### Querying for Specific Facility Information

**Notes:** To access specific facilities based on name, users must be in the **Permitted Facilities** layer before proceeding (as presented under **Access Facilities Information** section).



Under **Home** tab, click on **Query**.



Use the drop-down arrow under **Data Source** to switch to **Permitted Facilities**.

To access other information formats, follow the steps within **Querying for Specific Facility Information** before proceeding. After running your search inquiry, follow the steps below.

- Show Buffer Options

- Select All  
Add all items to the starred selection.
- Export to CSV

	<p>Select the required measurement units from the upper drop-down box.</p>
	<p>Click on the first facility and double click on the second facility to draw a measurement line between two facilities.</p> <p>The result will show the distance between two locations.</p>
	<p><b>Note:</b> To clear selection, click on <b>Clear</b> under <b>Measure</b> tab. Click <b>OK</b> on the pop-up window to confirm.</p>




To exit Measurement feature, click “x” sign on the panel on top of the map.






