Modified Living Benefit (Board and Room or Room Only)

A benefit for the cost of accommodation, food, clothing, personal needs and incidental expenses.

One Adult \$865

Transportation

Transportation benefits may be provided for medical treatment; attendance at day programs; attendance by children at school; attendance at a funeral or attendance at work; or other approved reasons.

Other Benefits

Disability Income Benefit – a \$70 per month benefit for adult clients with a disability who receive the Living Income benefit or the Modified Living benefit.

Northern Living Supplement - a monthly benefit may be provided to meet the additional costs of living in northern communities (\$50 per member of the family unit)

Household Task Benefit - a \$25 per month benefit may be provided to enable an eligible client or member of the family unit to pay for household tasks that the client or member of the family unit is unable to perform because of a disability.

Exceptional Needs Activity Benefit – a \$25 per month benefit may be provided to an eligible client who resides in approved private-service homes licensed through The Mental Health Services Act or The Residential

Services Act or in homes licensed through The Personal Care Homes Act.

Personal Living Benefit - a \$305 per month benefit may be provided for an adult client residing in a residential care facility, a hotel room where restaurant meals are required, a long-term residence that provides partial personal supports, a temporary residential facility or treatment centre, or other arrangements where the Living Income benefit is not provided. Children may receive \$55.
